Mr. Wilt opened the Public hearing for the Town of Arietta Law #1 for 2019 to override New York State's 2% tax cap for the 2020 town budget.

Mr. Wilt asked Mary Kiewicz-Chairperson of the Planning Board to inform the board of the progress of the update to the town septic system regulations. She handed the board a copy of the Queensbury, NY septic law and the septic committee's draft. She said that Queensbury doesn't do a town wide system inspection they do a property transfer system inspection. The inspections done by Queensbury personal costs \$250.00 and takes about 1 ½ to 2 hours. The wrote in their law that the Town board acts as the board for variance in these cases, it doesn't go to the Zoning board. It is like the Town board is acting kind of like the board of health. They make people put \$2,000.00 in escrow if the inspection can't be done due to weather or some other circumstance or other factors. The people will get the money back after the inspection is completed. The money is kept in escrow account with the Town board. The assessor sends the inspector of any deed changes so he can contact them and let them know what needs to be done. The sale of the property can't be finalized until this inspection is completed and the system fixed if needed and the Town gives a letter stating the sale can be completed. Mr. Wilt would like Hamilton County Soil & Water to do the inspections. He said there are some things that need to be changed to meet our Town's issues so he will give the board a week to review and give him suggestions. After the week he will send the draft to the Town Attorney for him to review and write up the local law.
