Mr. Small reported that all snowmobile trails have been groomed except the Willis trail as there is one bridge, they can't get over with the drag on. He has taken John with him twice to show him how to run the groomer and how to groom the Powley road and he will do fine. He is also going to take Chris down this week to reacquaint him with how to groom the Powley road again.

Mrs. Rudes reported that she had a meeting with Mr. Wilt, David Railsback the engineer from Schnabel and David Henley a representative from the Piseco Lake Association regarding the Piseco Lake dam. They focused on safety and effectiveness issues. Schnabel has agreed to give the Town board a conceptual level design alternatives for improvements to the dam that would make it safer to operate and hopefully keep

the lake level at a consistent recreational level during the summer months. They will evaluate three different dam styles and send the board this conceptual package. Mr. Wilt will contact Mr. Railsback before the next meeting to see if he can give a break down of the cost of the study so the board can evaluate that cost before going ahead with a design.

Mr. LaScola reported that he spoke to the architect and he wants to move ahead with the paperwork for the new salt shed on Route 10. Mr. Wilt said the salt shed was going to be paid for through the North Country Regional grant, right now there are not any grants. He told Mr. LaScola to allow the architect to go ahead to find out if the APA has jurisdiction, but no farther.

Mr. Wilt reported that he feels the board should back track a little bit on the septic law update. He feels there should be a smaller group to meet and go over it. He thinks Mr. LaScola needs to be in it because he understands what power he has. He will be on the panel, Mrs. Rudes also offered to be on it and Mr. Wilt asked Chris Rhodes if he would be on it. Mr. Rhodes agreed he would participate. Mr. Wilt will contact everyone and will set up a time.
