Steve Whorle reported on what the committee for the future of the Ambulance Corp has worked out so far. He reported they are meeting with the fire department to discuss their ideas. They would like to have the fire department budget raised to cover the proposed costs. They recommend the Town put on a laborer who would do odd jobs around the Town who is also an EMT. When there is an ambulance call they would respond. This would be for Monday through Friday from 6:00am to 6:00pm. After these hours from 6:00pm to 6:00am they would pay an EMT and driver per call. Saturday and Sunday they would pay

per call the EMT and driver on call more than what they would for evening personal. The actual money hasn't been figured out yet and nothing is set in stone. They are trying to get everything worked out by the first of the year.
