Subject: Reappoint a Commission of Five to Oversee the Local Law #1 of 2011 "A Local Law to Protect the Quality and regulate the Level of Piseco Lake in the Town of Arietta"

WHEREAS: the Town Board of Arietta is required to establish a commission of five people who must be at least eighteen years old and a citizen of the United States to carry out the intent of said Local Law #1 of 2011, and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Local Law #1 of 2011 the original commission appointed by the Town of Arietta Town Board by Resolution #12-06-17. is now defunct. Original members' terms expired during 2013 and 2014, with no subsequent appointments made, and

WHEREAS: the Town of Arietta, Town Board recognizes the need that appointments need to be made to the Commission as required by Local Law #1, 2011, and

WHEREAS: the Town of Arietta, Town Board after consideration will appoint the following five persons to act as commissioners to carry out the powers, duties and decisions as outlined in attached Local Law #1 of 2011 "A Local Law to Protect the Quality and Regulate the Level of Piseco Lake in the Town of Arietta, and

WHEREAS: the Commission of five will consist of the Town of Arietta Supervisor, the Town Safety Officer, the Highway Superintendent and two Town of Arietta Board members who will be appointed annually at the Town Board's annual organizational meeting, and

WHEREAS: some of the duties of the Commission may require immediate action prior to convening the full Commission. In such circumstances, the Town of Arietta Supervisor in consultation with the Town's Safety Officer and the Highway Superintendent is authorized to implement such immediate actions. Appropriate notification of such actions shall be made to the full Commission and the full Town Board, and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Local Law #1, decisions of the Commission may be appealed to the full Town Board within 20 days of such decision, and

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED: Town of Arietta Town Board will, by separate resolution 22-08-49, rescind resolution #12-06-17 which established the original commission. and

FURTHER, LET IT BE RESOLVED: that the Town of Arietta Town Board does appoint the Town Supervisor, the Town Safety Officer, the Town Highway Superintendent and two additional, annually appointed, Town of Arietta Town Board members to carry out all the powers and duties as stated in the attached Local Law #1 of 2012 "A Local Law to Protect the Quality and Regulate the Level of Piseco Lake in the Town of Arietta" effective immediately.

WHEREAS: the Town of Arietta is responsible for the placement and removal of planks in the Piseco Lake Outlet Spillway to maintain a stable Piseco Lake water level, and

WHEREAS: all placement and removal are weather and water level/ flow dependent, and

WHEREAS: the Town of Arietta has created procedures for the Piseco Lake Spillway for the purpose of the plank placement/removal as outlined in the attachment, and

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED: Town of Arietta Town Board will accept and follow the Piseco Lake Spillway Procedures as outlined in the attached document.

PISECO LAKE SPILLWAY PROCEDURES

The Town of Arietta (TOA) is responsible for the placement and removal of planks in the Piseco Lake Outlet spillway, The spillway is located where the outlet flows under the New York State Route 10 bridge in the Town of Arietta. An agreement/easement also exists between the TOA with the owner of the property, on which the spillway is located, allowing access to the spillway area for the purpose of such plank placement and removal.

The purpose of the plank placement/removal is to maintain (provide) a stable Piseco Lake Water Level at a height agreeable to shoreline residents, property owners and all users of Piseco Lake during the months during which the Lake is open, free of ice and the weather permits recreational use (May-October aka "the season"). Historically, the optimal goal has been to maintain the water level at 1660.61' above sea level. The TOA continues to utilize this as the optimal goal.

The spillway planks are put in place, in stages, during the Month of May and removed on or around the Columbus Day Holiday, also in stages. Adjustments to the planks between these dates, are made due to extraordinary circumstances. All placement and removal are weather and water level/ flow dependent. The Town Supervisor, in consultation with the Highway Superintendent/Town Safety Coordinator, as authorized by Town Board Resolution #22-08-50 will make the determination to place or remove the planks. The safety of the workers placing and removing the planks is the primary consideration. Weather forecast and availability of the Town's workforce are also determinants.

When in place, the spillway boards will be positioned so that an approximately three-foot (3') section is open at each end of the spillway to allow visible, free flowing water, as requested by the property owner and consistent with guidance provided by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.

TOA Board members will be notified, via e-mail, of the Supervisor's and Highway superintendent/Safety Coordinator's determinations regarding plank placement and removal. Courtesy e-mall notifications will also be made to the President of the PLA and the owner of the property on which the spillway is located. In addition, these actions will be noted on the Lake Level Record on the Town's website.
