Subject: REQUESTING AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT TO POST WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS ON TOWN ROADS FOR THE YEAR 2023
Resolution Offered By: Christy Wilt
WHEREAS: Vehicle and Traffic Law Article 41, Section 1660 gives authority to the Town Board to post weight limits on Town Roads when the Board deems necessary to protect roads from harm during spring breakup, and
WHEREAS: Vehicle and Traffic Law Article 40, Section 1650 gives authority to the county superintendent of highways to post weight limits on County Roads when the superintendent deems it necessary to protect County roads from harm during spring breakup, and
WHEREAS: the Town would need to place an ad in the local newspaper notifying the public of such postings, and
WHEREAS: the County Superintendent places a legal ad in the local newspaper notifying the public of such posting on County highways, and
WHEREAS: the Town roads are typically posted for the same duration as the County roads, and
WHEREAS: the Town Board and Town Highway Superintendent believes that it would be in the interest of the Town if the County Superintendent post weight restrictions on the Town roads in conjunction with the County Roads during spring breakup, be it
RESOLVED: the Town Board of the Town of Arietta hereby requests and authorizes the County Superintendent of Highways post weight restrictions on Town roads within the Town of Arietta when he deems necessary for the calendar year 2023.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Snowmobile Trails- J. Grier had nothing new to report from Frontier regarding the building.

<u>Town Buildings and Grounds</u>- D. Stobo reported there was a leak in the Community Hall roof. This will be addressed.

Internal Management/Insurance/Recreation/ Website and Chamber. C. Wilt reported there will be a JOB FAIR at Oak Mountain on February 22, 2023 from 4-8pm. The Birding Festival registration opened this morning and it is almost already full. C. Rhodes reported that Mary Hyde from the Piseco Yacht Club suggested possible activities for this summer, a Sailboat Parade around the lake, and a Moonlight Paddle from Poplar Point in July, being there will be a full moon.

<u>Lake/Dam/Invasive/Campsite</u>- S. Rudes had nothing to report.

<u>Finance/Airport-</u> C. Rhodes and board had a discussion regarding the siding for the Snow Removal Equipment Building on the Airport. At this time Supervisor Rhodes commended Superintendent Small for the job that he and his crew have been doing on the roads. They have done an excellent job.

<u>Highways</u>-Superintendent Craig Small was asked if he had anything to report. Craig stated that he had received no bids on the new trucks. He will continue to work on getting bids. He asked about the Settlement Agreement and Final Release of Rights for employees. Doug Stobo made a motion to accept, seconded by Jacqui Grier, AYES: D. Stobo, J. Grier, C. Wilt, C. Rhodes, S. Rudes abstained. Motion was passed. He has one full time employee retiring, Pete Doherty.
