Subject: Expand FDIC Coverage on Public Deposits Through the Use of a Qualified Reciprocal Deposit Program

Resolution Offered By: _____

WHEREAS: the Town of Arietta wishes to comply with NYS General Municipal Law regarding the security of public deposits that it has on deposit at any bank, and

WHEREAS: the Town of Arietta wishes to utilize a qualified Reciprocal Deposit Program as allowed under Chapter 128 of the NYS Laws of 2012 to increase the effective FDIC coverage and the rate of return on its public deposits, and

WHEREAS: the Town of Arietta recognizes and supports NBT Bank's desire to continue to lend money for small business loans, mortgages, commercial loans, and personal loans in the local communities it serves, and

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED: that the Supervisor is authorized to execute a Deposit Placement Agreement with NBT Bank to increase the FDIC insurance on those public deposits that the Town of Arietta invests in a qualified New York State-approved Reciprocal Deposit Program, and that there will be no charge to the Local Government for this program.

Subject: Hamilton County Solid Waste Transfer Station Refuse Disposal & Recycling Site Rules and Regulations

Resolution Offered By: _____

WHEREAS: Hamilton County has revised the Governance Policies effective June 23, 2026, for the Hamilton County Solid Waste Transfer Station Disposal & Recycling Facilities; and

WHEREAS: one of the existing requirements is that all household solid waste generated by residents brought to the transfer station shall be placed in clear, opaque/translucent, or white garbage bags to allow for inspection of contents. Black/Dark Green garbage bags will not be accepted, and Hamilton County reserves the right to reject any waste not meeting this requirement, as per the attached outline, and

WHEREAS: the Town of Arietta Highway Department has noted that residents are not following the rule of clear, opaque/translucent, or white garbage bags during the scheduled recycling, trash, and garbage pickups, and has tagged the residents with notice of this violation and any other rules and regulations regarding the transfer station; and

WHEREAS: there is still an issue with repeated violations and a need to address the situation, and after review and discussion, the Arietta Town Board will set the following rules for the scheduled recycling and trash pickups:

1. The Arietta Highway Department will tag the violations and leave the recyclables and/or trash at the residence.
2. If there are more than three (3) violations noting the use of bags other than clear, opaque/translucent, or white garbage bags from the same residence, the Town of Arietta will no longer offer any pickup service at the residence, which includes any dumpsters.
3. If dumpsters contain anything other than regular household solid waste, the Town will not remove the contents, and it is the responsibility of the owner/residents to take it to the transfer facility. (Some examples of non-household solid waste: construction debris, furniture, large rugs, major appliances, recyclables, batteries, electronics, and

anything else not following the policies set by Hamilton County.) Violations will be tagged by the Arietta Highway Department, and on the third (3) violation, the Town will no longer pick up at the location.

WHEREAS: failure by the Town of Arietta to comply with the Hamilton County Solid Waste Management site rules and regulations may subject the Town to being denied the ability to haul waste or recyclables to either transfer station, as well as possible reporting to regulatory agencies or any other action deemed appropriate by Hamilton County; and

NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED: that the Town of Arietta Town Board does approve the rules as outlined in this resolution to comply with Hamilton County regulations as outlined in the attachment effective immediately.
